In light of the Prime Ministers announcement on 16.03.2020 “**Now is the time for everyone to stop non-essential contact with others and stop all unnecessary travel**” Acorn Care will be restricting the access to the home and office to essential visitors only. In addition to this we will be only be facilitating necessary contact and travel outside of the home and office.

From the 17th of March 2020 Acorn Care are taking the following action in respect of Baydale house.

- All meetings scheduled at Baydale house will be postponed to a future date or held via Skype or conference call.
- All external activities which include either staff and/ or young people will be postponed until future date.
- All training will be postponed until further notice.
- New admissions will be postponed until further notice.
- Staff will not be facilitating or supervising any family contacts until further notice.

The Directors, Management team and staff of Acorn care are working closely with our health and safety consultant to ensure we are putting all possible precautions in place in line with the Government and Darlington council's guidelines.
